



Durham Court Holiday Apartments Schoolies House Rules

- Check-in begins at 2pm on day of arrival.
- Check-out ends at 10am on day of departure.
- Each booked and registered Schoolie at Durham Court (with Durham Court Schoolies wristband) is permitted to stay overnight. Friends of Schoolies who are booked and registered at Durham Court are permitted to visit from 7am to 6pm daily. All guests are to be informed of the house rules and must adhere to them.
- No Smoking indoors. You may smoke on the balcony if you are in staying in a 2-bedroom or 3-bedroom apartment, or at the front of the building in smoking area.
- You are required to dispose of all Rubbish daily (in the steel bins in the basement near the lift)
- No excessive noise (slamming doors, screaming, very loud music)
- After 10pm, no noise is to be heard from outside the units. Continue your celebrations on the beach or on Cavill Avenue
- All Australian laws and council regulations apply to Schoolies just as they would to any visitor to Gold Coast.
- Alcohol is allowed for 18+, however no glass is to be brought on the premises.
- After hours assistance is available for emergencies. A call out fee of \$50 is incurred for non-emergency call outs between 7pm and 8am (this includes locking yourself out of your room)
- Lost keys will incur a \$200 charge
- It is expected that you will leave your unit in the condition you found it. Upon departure, an inspection of the unit will be made. The cost of any damages, missing items or any incidentals in unit or common areas will need to be covered.
- We are in a premium location in town, extremely close to the beach / party location. Enjoy, Don't Destroy.
- Serious breaches of the above rules, or loud, obnoxious, abusive, drunken behaviour towards staff or other guests will result in Instant Eviction and No Refund.
- In making a booking, all guests have agreed to follow the above House Rules.
